LIBRARY-RELATED INFORMATION:

The Beekman Library is following the guidance of NY State and the CDC in regards to COVID-19. We have a phased level of service established which is based on the level of Covid-19 cluster activity within our community. Our plan includes strict cleaning protocols, distancing, mask requirements, and quarantining of materials.

The Library is currently operating at Service Level C.
